

New Mandatory PIM Attributes FAQ

1. What are the new Mandatory PIM Attributes that Vendors need to fill out?

There are two new Mandatory PIM Attributes that you need to fill out – they are TRUE/FALSE questions:

- Product is considered Dangerous Goods
- Product is eligible to ship to the US

If either of these are TRUE, there are additional attributes that you need to fill in.

If Product is considered Dangerous Goods = TRUE:

- Special Handling/Storage Requirements
- Dangerous Goods Classification

If Product is eligible to ship to the US = TRUE:

- Product is Infant/Children Sleepwear
- Product is for Children <= 12 Years Old
- Product is Arts & Crafts Supplies
- Product contains Wood or Plant Material
- Product is made of Textile Material
- Product comes in contact with Food or Drink
- Product is a Medical Device
- Product is for Skincare
- Product is a Ride-On Toy
- Manufacturer's Name***
- Manufacturer's Address***
- Material Content***
- Product Has Tracking Labels****
- Product Has Sleepwear Labels*****

***Mandatory if any of the following are TRUE: Product contains Wood or Plant Material, Product is made of Textile Material, Product comes in contact with Food or Drink, Product is a Medical Device, Product is for Skincare

****Mandatory if any of the following are TRUE: Product is Infant/Children Sleepwear, Product is for Children <= 12 Years Old, Product is Arts & Crafts Supplies

*****Mandatory if Product is Infant/Children Sleepwear is TRUE

2. Where in PIM are these new attributes located?

The Dangerous Goods Attributes can be found on the Products tab under *IF-Dangerous Goods*

3. Will I have to fill out these attributes for older products that are already in PIM?

No. These attributes will only apply to newly created articles in PIM. They will not affect updates to older articles, and you do not need to update older articles.

4. How do I know if I need to upload documents?

If certain attributes are TRUE, you will need to upload documents. The PIM system will let you know which documents are required. The below table lists which documents are required for which attributes and the correct Prefixes to use to name your files so that PIM recognizes that the documents meet the requirements.
